More than 100 older adults and their supporters recently gathered under sunny skies at the Georgia Capitol on **Be There 4 Seniors Day** to thank Governor Nathan Deal for including \$4.2 million in new funding for seniors in his proposed 2017 budget. The funding would be dedicated to home and community based services, such as home-delivered meals and adult day care that help older adults live independently at home. Governor Deal also included an additional \$750,000 in the budget for meals to fight senior hunger.

More than 9,000 Georgians are on waiting lists for in-home services.
