

The Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (MARTA) is seeking individuals with disabilities and seniors to represent the following areas of expertise:

- ➤ Upper/Lower Extremity Impairment
- Cognitive/Developmental Disabilities
- Personal Mobility Aid/Wheelchair User
- ➤ Deaf/Hard of Hearing
- > Seniors (Must be 65 years of age or older)

MARTA has established the MARTA Accessibility Committee (MAC), a voluntary advisory committee organized to advise MARTA on how to best provide service to the communities of seniors and individuals with disabilities within the MARTA service areas of Clayton, DeKalb and Fulton, counties and the City of Atlanta. MAC's responsibilities include gathering and providing feedback to MARTA to ensure that decisions, activities, programs, and services are equitable and do not adversely impact current or potential riders who are seniors or individuals with a disability. MAC provides feedback to MARTA regarding policies, programs, and processes; this includes advice regarding targeted outreach efforts designed to solicit and gauge community input and facilitate examining all facts to ensure the non-discriminatory impact of the agency's decisions and activities.

Candidates are required to participate in an application and panel interview process. Interest candidates must also:

- 1. Reside or work in the MARTA service areas of Clayton, DeKalb, and Fulton counties and the City of Atlanta, or be employed with organizations providing services in the MARTA service areas within Clayton, DeKalb, and Fulton counties and the City of Atlanta.
- 2. Know the purpose and mission of the MAC and the ADA as it applies to public transportation.
- 3. Be a transit rider who knows how to utilize the MARTA system. (Fixed Route or Mobility).
- 4. Be active in the disability communities they represent, as demonstrated by participation in organizations or community groups.
